



Pause Bristol Practice Lead

Are you an ambitious, creative and influential leader or practitioner who is passionate about reducing the number of children being removed into care by supporting women to bring about change in their lives?

Pause is a national independent organisation seeking to prevent the damaging consequences of thousands more children being taken into care each year by working with women who have experienced – or are at risk of – repeated pregnancies that result in children needing to be removed from their care. The programme gives women the chance to pause and take control over their lives, breaking a destructive cycle that causes both them and their children deep trauma, as well as reducing huge costs to society and the taxpayer. Pause is setting up programmes around the country and One25 have secured funding to host an 18-month pilot programme in Bristol.

Practice Lead Role

As a Pause Bristol Practice Lead you will provide leadership to this exciting pilot programme to ensure the implementation and delivery of an integrated package of health, therapeutic and social support. You will lead a small team, working flexibly and collaboratively to improve outcomes for vulnerable and marginalised women. You will be passionate about changing entrenched social issues, and will respond by 'doing things differently'.

Please note: secondments for the Practice Lead role from relevant partner agencies will be considered – This could be from Children's Services, Adult Services, Health, Probation, Mental Health Services, or other relevant voluntary services.
